

## Application and Registration Information:

The deadline for applications is **March 30** (after March 30 applications will be reviewed if space permits). An application packet\* for the Summer Vocology Institute 2012 must include the following:

1. **A completed Registration Form:** Please fill out, sign, and date (form provided below).
2. **A resume:** Include educational and professional experience. Any professional honors, publications, or presentations should be noted.
3. **A transcript:** Please use your most recent degree program.
4. **Three letters of recommendation:** It is best to have these done by a professor or an overseer at your work. They may be sent under separate cover or by email.

5. **A statement of past experiences and professional goals:** Although the format will vary from individual to individual, these personal statements should include summaries of previous professional and educational experiences that were of a concentrated nature similar to the SVI as well as a description of how the SVI will facilitate attainment of future goals.

Applications received after **March 30** will be reviewed on a space-available basis until **May 4**. The registration packet may be emailed, faxed, or mailed. If you fax or mail you application packet, we would request that you send us an email so that we know to look for your packet. An application packet for the Summer Vocology Institute 2012 must include the following: 1. <b>A completed admission form.</b> You must include this form. 2. <b>A resume</b> with relevant educational and professional experience. Any professional honors, publications or presentations should be noted. 3. <b>A transcript</b> from your most recent degree program. 4. <b>Three letters of recommendation.</b> These may be sent under separate cover. 5. <b>A statement of past experiences and professional goals.</b> Although the format will vary from individual to individual, these personal statements should include summaries of previous professional and educational experiences that were of a concentrated nature similar to the SVI as well as a description of how the SVI will facilitate attainment of future goals.	<b>Credit, tuition and fees:</b> Graduate credit will be given by The University of Iowa's Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders through UI's Center for Credit Programs. Graduate students enrolled at other institutions may arrange to transfer credits to their own institutions. Continuing Education Credits are to be arranged in advance by the student through the student's university, state credentialing body or through ASHA with the assistance of SVI staff. Since the SVI is administered through Iowa's Center for Credit Programs, participants are eligible for the low, in-state graduate tuition rate of \$259.00* per semester hour for undergraduate and \$404.00* per semester hour for graduate credit. Some courses have an additional course fee to cover expenses related to software purchases, equipment rentals, photocopies, and other lab supplies used in the courses. Tuition and course fees are billed online through the University of Iowa's Cashier's Office beginning on June 1.  *Tuition rates are for 2011 and may be subject to change.
